



## PRIMATE LODGE KIBALE FOREST NATIONAL PARK

### THE LODGE

- Nine deluxe ensuite forest cottages and one honeymoon cottage with ensuite bedroom, lounge, large terrace and private fire pit. All cottages have private spacious verandas with views into the forest.

### LOCATION

- Located inside Kibale Forest National Park, a few minutes walk from the chimpanzee tracking start point at Kanyanchu Visitors Centre. The forest is home to 13 species of primates and over 370 bird species.

### USEFUL INFORMATION

- The lodge is powered by solar electricity and has a back up generator. We kindly request that you use power sensitively and turn off lights and equipment when not in use.
- Power is provided with 3 pin British plugs and all cameras, phones, laptops etc can be charged in your room.
- Please note that PrimateLodge is situated in a wildlife habitat, therefore we kindly request that you leave your doors closed after entering and leaving your room. Please do not bring food into the rooms as it can attract insects and other animals. Please allow a member of our team to accompany you to your room during the hours of dusk and dawn.
